

Southern Region Boatswain 2015-16 Nomination Guidelines

Qualifications:

- Be a registered Sea Scout in a council within the Southern Region
- Be approved to serve as the Region Boatswain by his or her council
- Be less than 20 years of age on May 31, 2015

Responsibilities:

- Represents Sea Scouting at:
 - ❖ the Southern Region Board Meetings **October 2015** (Wednesday – Friday)
 - ❖ the Southern Region Board Meetings **February 2016** (Thursday & Friday), and at
 - ❖ Winterfest **February 5-7, 2016** (Fri-Sun)
- Represents Southern Region Sea Scouting at national meetings (when designated)
- Represents Southern Region Sea Scouting at other Scouting events (when designated)
- Serves as Vice-President of Sea Scouting in the Southern Region Venturing Officers Association
- Serves on other Special Projects, Programs, or Activities as designated by the region
- Promotes national, regional, and area Sea Scouting and Venturing activities, programs, and awards
- Serves in a leadership position for any Southern Region event as requested by the Southern Region Venturing President or the Southern Region Commodore
- Agrees to wear a Sea Scouting uniform and identity items as suggested by the regional leadership
- Agrees to resign from office if requested to do so by the regional leadership

Term of Office:

The Southern Region Boatswain will serve from June 1, 2015 through May 31, 2016.

Action:

1. Councils should then approve and forward the attached nomination form to the selection committee by **May 20, 2015**
2. The Southern Region Boatswain Selection Committee will in turn make their selection known by May 31, 2015.

Additional Information:

The nominee should attach no more than two 8.5 x 11 inch pages on white paper to this nomination stating his or her qualifications for the Southern Region Boatswain position. Please do not enclose them in notebooks, binders, or sheet protectors. These pages may include:

- Any experience as a Ship or Council Boatswain
- Any experience as the chairperson or other officer of your council's Teen Leader Council, Venturing Officer's Association, or similar council, area, or region level organization
- Leadership experience, awards, training, and other activities related to Sea Scouting and/or Venturing
- Honors, leadership positions, awards, and training from church, Scouting, or other organizations
- School awards, clubs, sports, scholarships, and leadership positions
- A statement on your college or career plans
- A brief statement on why you want to be the Southern Region Boatswain
- Other information on your qualifications for the position
